Essentially, the Ninth Circuit Court determined 30-day

impounds to be 4th Amendment violations, regardless of the Legislative Intent written 14607.4 VC. If the car is not being held with evidentiary value or under warrant, it should be released to a person that would otherwise qualify for a release under 2261(p) VC. The impound is lawful...holding it is not.
