Good morning, Dr. Cornner, and happy new year. My apologies for the delayed response to your initial inquiry. Given the existing Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Therapy programs approved as part of the original community college baccalaureate program, LACCD's program would not represent duplication of existing CSU programs. However, for our records, we would like to request a copy of the four-year degree plan or a list of the required major-specific courses required for the proposed B.S. program at LAVC. Whatever document would illustrate the major-specific curriculum to be required for the baccalaureate program would be sufficient. If you could please forward this to my attention at your earliest convenience it would be appreciated.

We appreciate your patience as we have been working through this new process with our partners in the California Community College Chancellor's Office. In the future, we anticipate providing a more delineated review process for such programs. Thank you and LACCD for being our trial-run at this new endeavor!

Good afternoon, Dr. Cornner. On behalf of Executive Vice Chancellor Alva, thank you for your message and outreach.

Given the recency of Assembly Bill 927, we are still finalizing our CSU process and consulting with our colleagues in the California Community College Chancellor's Office so that these processes can be streamlined and as complementary as possible. As you note, similar proposals were approved under the pilot baccalaureate program in 2014. However, I anticipate there will be a minimal amount of additional information regarding LACCD's proposed Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Therapy program we would like for this review process. Greetings Dr. Alva,

As you are aware, the state is allowing additional applications for baccalaureate degrees in the California Community College System. The Los Angeles Community College District is excited for this opportunity, having already created a successful baccalaureate program at West Los Angeles College. The legislation and associated processes require consultation with the UC and CSU systems to avoid duplication and ensure we are working collectively as systems of higher education. To that end, we are pleased to report that Los Angeles Valley College will be submitting an application in the coming month to offer a **Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Therapy**.

The Bachelor's in Science in Respiratory Therapy program allows graduates of AS degree Respiratory Care programs and licensed Respiratory Care Practitioners (RCP) a pathway to complete a four-year degree at Los Angeles Valley College. The curriculum provides advanced scope of practice and education with emphasis in advanced cardiopulmonary pathophysiology, advanced respiratory case management, advanced respiratory neonatal/pediatrics, health education in respiratory care, research methodology, quantitative principles, respiratory care sleep medicine, and respiratory care leadership and management.

We are confident that this program will result in success for our students and serve as an equity driver leading to increased economic mobility and exceptional service in our communities. We hope that you will be able to echo our enthusiasm for this program. This program has previously been consulted and approved when Skyline College and Modesto College were given approval during the pilot program and have been successful in conferring BSRT degrees. It will be a great opportunity to bring this program to Southern California.

Please let me know if there is any other information that is needed to support the consultation process and let us know if there are any other individuals that we should be consulting with.
